

Painting 1 2 3 supply list

Supply list:

- Paper Palette – disposable sheets, or you may use Styrofoam plates or freezer paper
- Thinner – turpenoid
- 1-2 small jars if using oil paint.
- Container for water if using acrylic
- Rags
- Paper towels
- Canvas – stretched canvas or canvas board. If this is your first painting, buy a canvas or board no larger than 16x20. A small canvas is good for a first painting.
- Easel – wait to buy an easel. If you have one, bring to class. Table easels are ok.
- Photos or pictures you might like to paint or use as inspiration for your first painting.

Brushes – It is better to have a few good brushes than a large cheap set.

- Flat brushes – small, medium and large (no bigger than 1")
- Round brushes- small and medium
- 1 small detail brush
- Palette knife for mixing, (plastic is ok)

Paints – Oil is recommended, but you may also use acrylic. Student grade paints will be cheaper. Beginner sets will suffice. You may want to purchase individually or add some of the colors below to a set.
